The Asian Harm Reduction Network (AHRN)-Myanmar is an International Non-Governmental organization, which is implementing a harm reduction programme to reduce HIV transmission among people injecting drugs, their (sexual) partners and the communities they live in by providing support to implementation of harm reduction interventions and to create an enabling and supporting environment through advocacy, capacity building, training and service provision.

AHRN-Myanmar is looking for highly motivated and reliable individuals who are keen to be part of an active team/organization that delivers wide range of services to improve the health of vulnerable person to fill in the position of “**X-Ray Technician**” for its ongoing Harm Reduction activities in Myanmar.

- The position is full-time, based in **Hpakant, Kachin State** with a probation period of three months.
- Application deadline : **7 May 2026**
- Starting date of the contract : **As soon as possible**

Personal and Professional Requirements

- Myanmar national with University Degree (B.P.Sc or B.Med.Tech - Medical Imaging Technology) or X-Ray technician (Grade I/ Grade II).
- Having experience will be an advantage;
- Fluent in Myanmar and Good command of English;
- Good communication and networking (interpersonal) skills;
- Resident of job location (or) Knowledge of local dialect will be given preference;

Main Responsibilities

- Maintain the high quality of the X-ray diagnostic service;
- To operate the digital X-ray machine as written in the operation manual (Portable/Ultra-Portable X ray unit) regarding diagnosing Tuberculosis;
- To ensure X-ray findings are readable and high quality;

- To maintain Portable/ Ultra-Portable Digital X-ray equipment and accessories in a clean and operable condition by conducting regular daily, weekly, monthly and yearly maintenance;
- To ensure there are sufficient materials to enable the Portable/Ultra-portable Digital X-ray to function efficiently and inform supervisors if there are any problems (shortage or surplus or malfunctioning) related to X-ray machines and accessories;
- To follow sensible health and safety procedures, including the use of appropriate protective materials and the safe handling of equipment as per supplier's instruction, national and DAE guidelines;
- To follow infection control measures in the X-ray room/ X-ray taking places as per national infection control guidelines;
- To take relevant action to prevent potential data loss from software and computer such as regular saving of patient data in external hard disk;
- To follow the national guidelines for external quality assurance of CXR results;
- To perform and maintain the CAD equipment including software and hardware, for sustainability;
- To assist the Medical Coordinator for CAD software handling and troubleshooting;
- To maintain all records of X-ray and CAD equipment related to machine installation data (e.g., Installation date, Sr.no., training data, etc.), troubleshooting, and other necessary data if present;
- To maintain register books to record all X-rays taken and their results;
- To collect necessary X-ray and CAD data and submit to the respective supervisor. (For example, monthly report forms & quality control data);
- To maintain records of all the servicing /maintenance/repair done on X-ray machine and internal quality control log sheet;
- To identify the training needs by direct observation and develop the training plan together with PC(HQA);
- To provide/ facilitate the internal training to the new X-ray staff regarding effective use of X-ray equipment, image quality control, and assurance, radiation hazard as required;
- To provide briefing, recruitment training, on the job orientation, and coaching sessions of X-ray facilities for newly recruited X-ray technicians in AHRN
- To maintain regular communication with the supplier company and service engineers to ensure routine maintenance and prompt troubleshooting in the event of any technical issues or errors with portable/ Ultra- portable digital X-ray machines.
- To assist Medical Coordinator and the team for smooth operation in mobile activities;
- To perform other X-ray related tasks when required;
- The employee might have to re-assign the duty station other than the originally assigned project as per project needs.
